

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE PLANNING ADVISORY COMMITTEE (PAC)

The Municipality of Brome Village invites citizens interested in serving on the Planning Advisory Committee (PAC) to submit their application to fulfill two vacant positions following the adoption of the new municipal by-law to this effect.

The primary responsibility of the Committee is to provide advice and recommendations to the Municipal Council on matters relating to planning, development, zoning, subdivision and construction. In instance, it studies requests for minor exemptions and amendments to urban planning by-laws.

The committee meets privately and is made up of five members: the Mayor, a Municipal Councillor and three citizens appointed by the Municipal Council for a two-year term. Meetings are held a few times a year, usually in the evening, at the discretion of the committee members.

Citizens interested in applying should submit a letter of interest, outlining their skills, expertise, training or interest in architecture, construction or urban planning as an asset to join the committee.

Application and registration deadline

Interested parties must submit their letter of interest by <u>April 28, 2021</u>, either by email: <u>admin@bromevillage.ca</u> or directly at the Town Hall located at 330 Stagecoach Road, Brome, QC, J0E 1KO.

Municipal Council will nominate members of the committee among the applications received.
